TRAUMA AND POVERTY**

Refugee Crisis

The Rohingya have faced decades of repression under radical terrorism and mass genocide.

Over 1 million Rohingya refugees have been placed on 600 acres of land. They remain the largest and most displaced people group in the world.

Although they've escaped persecution, they now live confined to camps, restrictive of movement, and cut off from adequate sources of clean water, food, healthcare, education, and a semblance of normal livelihood. All of this, tied together with rusty barbed wire and no escape.

Through Mercy's efforts and those of our ministry partners, we continue to provide clean water wells in the camps where we are still allowed access. As these countries become more and more radicalized, restrictions and permissions become increasingly difficult to bypass- making our window of opportunity increasingly narrowed.

We can pray that the Lord would continue to make a way for seeds of hope to be planted throughout the camps through the forms of education, sewing projects, the distribution of Bibles, and church plants.



Compassion & the Gospel

Why Compassion ministries? Acts of Compassion open the door for the Gospel of Christ to be shared in countries that are closed to Christianity. This is a unique opportunity that we have together to spread the good news of Jesus to the darkest corners of the world.

Mercy, together with our ministry partners and you, our donors, have strategically played a significant role in fostering evangelism, church planting, and discipleship through compassion ministries (drilling wells, skills training in agriculture, literacy, distributing food and medical provisions) in 14 countries.

As we drill wells that provide life-saving clean water we are granted permission to distribute Holy Books (Bibles) in Muslim communities. This has been powerfully effective. As people read the Bible, in their own language and the safety of their homes, the Holy Spirit is breathing the words to life and we are seeing the good news of the Gospel transforming hopelessness in the dark parts of this world. This is how we reach the unreached - through compassion, kindness, trust, and obedience. Then, we allow the presence of Jesus to call these precious people to Himself in a way that only the living, breathing Word of God can.

BREAK EVERY CHAIN



*These are girls from a school in South Asia where Mercy had the honor of drilling a well so that their community could have access to safe water.

After years of living in a brothel, with smells of human feces, truck exhaust and the stench of disease-infested creatures scampering along dark, dank alleyways, you stop dreaming of being rescued. Ever since being sold to Madam at 13 years of age, false hope and misrepresented safety started to blur together with the faces who have visited you there. Approximately 9am is when your day starts. Every hour, and on through the night- more men coming and going.

Cotton curtains cordon off your beds as homemade liquor poured from plastic bottles numb your reality. Shirtless men swagger down the alleyways looking for girls. TK 400 (about \$4.09 USD) is the average cost for 10 minutes with one of these women.

In these brothels, between 3,000-4,000 women and young girls ages 10 and older are being trafficked against their will.

Through the work of our organization, the hope here is that their past will not be their future.

With the help of our partnered organization, a recovery agency for global human trafficking, Mercy and our ministry partners seek to save at-risk girls from a life of slavery and sex work. Working with brothel madams and mothers, we've begun to develop shared trust in order to house and rehabilitate these young girls. Our goal is to provide education, trauma therapy, medical attention, life skills, and a chance at a better life. These girls have already shown to have a higher IQ rating compared to other children, with a vast potential for adapting and overcoming from the circumstances they were born into.
